“Cleo’s design is unique and attractive, but also intentionally minimal to let the beauty of the markerglass work surface become the hero,” says Ayako Takase of Kaiju Studios. “Our design goal was a simple structure that’s both utilitarian and poetic in form.”

Cleo Mobile Magnetic Markerglass is available in White tempered safety glass. The glass may be customized using our Vitracolor® and AST™ techniques for adding color and printing. Or try Cleo with Organize™ Magnetic Markerglass by Suzanne Tick.

The Easel comes with a Bamboo tray, Bamboo storage shelf, and metal display rack. The Divider is fitted with a Felt accessory cup. Both are available with either Metallic Silver or White steel frame.
